

POINT SYSTEM EXPLAINED

Basic Requirements

Each U8 through U14 team must accumulate at least 18 ref points each season to participate in post-season play. No points are awarded for U6 games (since you can do your own kids game) or Upper Division (U16 and U19) matches which are covered by a different system. Your kids' team(s) receive one ref point for each U8 through U14 match that you referee. Surplus referee points are not transferable to teams with deficits. We want each team to be responsible for meeting its obligations. If you have two kids on different teams, both teams receive points for the games you do. In order to get the points, all you need to do is sign up (at: <http://www.cgisports.com/ref/2131/>) and ref those games.

Credit for Refing Own Kid's Matches

We don't allow you to sign up to ref your own kids' games (except U6 and U8G at Kenter Avenue School) However, new this year, if you sign up and ref a game and ALSO fill in on your kids game for a no show or vacancy, we will give you credit for the fill-in. To get credit, for the fill-in you must notify your referee division captain within 72 hours of the game.

Credit for Referee Training Course

Also new this year we will award new and returning refs three points for successfully completing the basic referee course (not the U6 course) provided the newly trained or re-trained refs sign up and ref at least two games over the following three weekends (for which they will also receive credit).

Credit for Mentoring

Points may be awarded for mentoring assignments with the prior approval of the referee administration.

Upper Division

Upper Division matches (U16 and U19) are covered by a different system. On-line sign ups for those games are found at <http://www.ayso76.net/new/inleague/index.cfm>. As a region we are required to cover our "fair share" of games. No team is assigned a quota of games to cover. If one ref from our region does 20 games, the entire region benefits, regardless of that ref's team affiliation. If a ref/parent does a UD game and also has a kid playing in our regions lower divisions (U8-U14) the lower division team does not receive any credit for the UD games

the parent does. When creating your profile for our in-Region scheduling system, you should not enter your upper division team number as your upper division team gets no credit for the lower division matches you cover.
